- Conducting external supplier/subcontractor audits;
- Conducting visual and physical inspection, reconditioning and certification of aircraft parts and components;
- Supporting root cause and corrective actions and process improvements within the business;
- Identifying risks and planning mitigating actions to ensure compliance and improved quality;
- Providing technical assistance and quality training support to operations;
- Maintaining oversight of QA processes during distribution activities;
- Developing standard work process where required to continually improve the definition of QC inspection standards;
- Completing Non-Conformance Report dispositions when required;
- Maintaining the technical configuration of 3PA quality documentation;
- Working within the provisions and guidelines of the 3PA QA system;
- Safety – Responsible for personal safety, safe working practices etc. Understand and follow the 3PA OH&S procedures; and
